Judgement as above mentioned to be stollen to three pound ten shillings curr. money of Maryland and
that the said Jeremiah Liley be whipt at the publick whipping post with twenty five stripes on the Bare -
back well laid on until the blood appear and that he stand immediately in the pillory half an hour
and that his back be taken off and thereupon as to the corporate punishment as command is given to the
Sheriff of Somerset County that he do hereof immediate Execution according to the Judgment as -
Rendered by whipping the said Jeremiah Liley at the Publick whipping post with Twenty five Strips
on his Bare Back well laid on until the blood appear and by standing in the pillory Immediately
One half hour and afterwards in the same Court have the said Sheriff and make return that he had
Done the Execution of the Judgment as to the corporate punishment as he was Commanded &c

The Same .. } Somerset County &c. The Jurors for the right honourable, the Lord proprietary/that
now is for the Body of Somerset County as upon their oaths do present that -
The Same .. } Jeremiah Liley late of Stegny parish in the County of Bedfawre the twenty second
day of May in the year of our Lord 1716 seventeen hundred thirty and six with force and arms
the Mansion house of Alexander Fullerton at the parish aforesaid in Somerset County aforesaid in
the night time to wit between the hours of ten and eleven after the noon of the same day -
(certain negroes nam the slave of a certain George Carris then in the peace of God and of
the said Lord proprietary in the same Mansions house being) feloniously and burglarily did
break and enter and enter into one of the values of one shilling current money of Maryland
one pair of Gloves of the value of six pence like money, and one white Linnen shirt of the
value of ten shillings like money of the goods and Chattels of the aforesaid Alexander Fullerton
in the said house then and there being found ther and there feloniously and burglarily
did steal take and carry away contrary to the peace of the said Lord proprietary that
now is his good rule and Government &c

To Mr. Alexander Fullerton. --- On the Backside of the foregoing Case of Judgment it was thus Endorsed

And afterward to wit the fifteenth day of June anno domini One thousand Seven hundred and Ninety
Six (and) to wit the said Jeremiah Liley for his proper person before the Justices of his Lordships
County Court of Somerset and being by the Sheriff set to the County. Whereupon the said Jeremiah
Liley is committed into the custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County that he remain until his delivery
from hence by due course of Law. and that he have him before the Justices of the next assize or
termire and that delivery to be held for Somerset County about eight weeks the first Tuesday of Sep-
tember next to answer &c
