Been under before the laying of the attachment and that then the said Samuel Wilson shall make restitution unto the said Thomas Gray of all or such part hereof as shall be made appear to be justly due or that he the said George Gray do it for him. Therefore it is considered by the Justices here that the goods and chattels of the aforesaid attached and appraised to the value of four pounds twelve shillings and six pence be condemned as of the goods and chattels of the aforesaid Thomas Gray toward satisfying unto the aforesaid Samuel Wilson the sum of three pounds sterling his damages and all costs and charges accruing by means of the attachment of that he have thereof payment the same.

RECD John Dennis Junr. memorandum the self-same day his late ship's Writ attachment against the debt the sum whereof is as follows.

John Donelson Jr. of Somerset Dist -- Somerset Co. Charles absolute Lord and proprietor of the Province of Maryland and avowed Baron of Baltimore &c. To the Sheriff of Somerset County Greeting we command you that you attach any the goods Chattles rights or credits of John Donelson late of Somerset County Mariner if they shall be found in your bailiwick to the value of six thousand pounds of tobacco and nine pounds current money of Maryland and when you have these me attached or any parte thereof the same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June next then and there to be condemned according to act assembly to and for the use of a certain John Dennis Junr unless the said John Donelson by himself or his attorney shall appear and answer unto the said John Dennis Junr in a plea of trespass upon the case &c. According to law and that by good and lawfull men of your bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before our Justices of our County Court to be held as aforesaid to shew cause if any he she or they have why the same goods Chattles rights or credits so attached in his or their hand ought not to be condemned and executed thereof had and made according to act of assembly (in such case made and provided) if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall execute this writ that you make known unto our said Justices at the day and place aforesaid and have you then and there this writ witness John Smith gent one of our Justices of our said Court the twentieth day of March anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty five.

All which said writ Tuesday of June (anwitt) the fifteenth day of the same month and anno Domini thousand Seven hundred and Ninety Six being the day of the return of the said Writ witness the said John Dennis by Robert Dennis his attorney and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed I declare and make return thereof to the Court hereunder set in these words following vizt. By virtue of the within Writ to me directed to his Justice with mentioned & certifie that I have attached of the goods and chattels of Jas. John Donelson to the value -
