of Somerset County Greeting we command you that you attach any the goods Chattels rights or Credits of John Donelson late of Somerset County Mariner if they shall be found in your bailiwick to the value of six thousand pounds of tobacco and nine pounds current money of Maryland and when you have the same attached or any parts thereof the same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same before our Justice of our County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June next then and there to be condemned according to act of assembly to and for the use of a certain John Dennis Junr. unless the said John Donelson by himself or his attorney shall appear and answer unto the said John Dennis Junr. in a plea of trespass upon the case &c. According to Law and that by good and Lawfull men of your bailiwick you make known unto the persons or persons in whose hands you make the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before our Justice of our County Court to be held as aforesaid to shew cause if any he she or they have why the same goods Chattels rights or Credits so attached in his or their hand ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to act of assembly (in such case made and provided) if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall Execute this writ that you make known unto our said Justice at the day and place aforesaid and have you there and there this Writt witness John Smith Gent. one of our Justice of our said Court the twentieth day of March Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty five.
