Dennis doth not gain say. Whereupon all the prayer of the said John Dennis by his attorney of the Court here valued the said three pounds Curr. money so as it is attached and confessed by the said Francis Porter to be worth six hundred pounds of tobacco &c.

Thereupon the said John Dennis by his attorney of pray that upon giving Security according to act of assembly the Several goods and Chattels so as it is attached to the value of Nine pounds two shillings Curr. money and five thousand and five pounds of tobacco and three pounds in the hands of the said Francis Porter may be all condemned as of the goods and Chattels Rights and Credits of the said John Donelson towards Satisfying unto the the said John Dennis Ind. his Damages and all Costs and Charges accruing by means of the attachment &c.

Thereupon William Lane of Somerset County Sheriff present herein Court in his proper person undertook for the said John Dennis Ind. according to act of assembly in such case provided that in case the said John Donelson do at any time within a year and a day appear and make all or any part of the said John Dennis's Claim against him appear to be satisfied or otherwise to have been made before the saying of this attachment that then the said John Dennis shall make restitution unto him the said John Donelson of all or such part thereof as shall be made appear to be undue &c. or that he the said William Lane will do it for him &c.

Therefore it is Considered by the Court here that the Several goods and Chattels so as it is attached to the value of Nine pounds two shillings Curr. money and five thousand and five pounds of tobacco be condemned as of the goods and Chattels of the same John Donelson towards Satisfying unto the said John Dennis Ind. as well his Damages as all Costs and Charges accruing upon the writ of attachment &c. and that he have thereof his Execution according to act of assembly &c.

Likewise it is Considered by the Justices here that the said sum of three pounds Curr. money so as it is attached and confessed (valued as it is by the Court here to six hundred pounds of tobacco) be condemned in the hands of the said Francis Porter as of the Rights and Credits of the said John Donelson towards Satisfying unto the said John Dennis Ind. his Damages &c. as all his Costs and Charges accruing upon the writ of attachment &c. that he have thereof his Execution according to act of assembly &c.
