 in the hands of Ambrose Riggini the goods and Chattels mentioned in the schedule hereunto annexed as of the goods
 and Chattels of Stephen Dear within mentioned for the Use of Joseph Tillman Licitavit within named and
 I further certify that at the same Time and place did make division unto the same Ambrose Riggini that he
 should be and appear as within directed before Francis Porter and John Doe good & Lawfull men of my County
 with so answers --- Joseph M^r Carter sh^{er}.

A schedule of the goods of Stephen Dear taken by virtue of an attachment for the Use of Joseph
 Tillman whose Names are under Written being Lawfully Seized and Sworn by the Sheriff do value

 by his attorney aforesaid present his own Court pray
 that upon giving Security according to act of assembly in such case made
 and provided the said severale goods and Chattels so as aforesaid
 of the value of two pounds & sixteen shillings & one penny Court money
 and Seven hundred & thirty four pounds of tobacco may be condemned
 in the hands of the said Ambrose Riggini as the proper goods and Chattels
 of the said Stephen Dear towards satisfying unto the said Joseph Tillman
 man his damages off to wit Seven pounds & eleven shillings and eight pence
 Court money and also all costs and charges answering by means of the
 attachment aforesaid.
