Thereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the aforesaid Winnifred Abden if she should be found in his bailiwick if she to answer and afterwards to with the same on the day of June and send one thousand seven hundred thirty five before the Justice of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset now here held at Dividing Creek in the same County came the said Winnifred Abden in her proper person answering to a certain Recognizance by her and her security in that part first acknowledged and had a hearing of the Indictment aforesaid and being instantly demanded how she would acquit herself of the premises aforesaid above by the Indictment upon her imposed, says that of the premises aforesaid above upon her imposed she is guilty thereof and is willing to pay her fine for the fact aforesaid.

Whereupon all and singular the premises by the Court here seen heard and fully understood and mature Deliberation thereupon had It is thereupon considered by the Justice here that the aforesaid Winnifred Abden pay unto his Lordship the Right honorable the Lord Proprietor for her fine by the Court here upon her imposed for and by occasion of the premises aforesaid whereof in fine aforesaid she is Convict thirty shillings current money for the use of the County aforesaid and that the said Winnifred Abden be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine aforesaid. Whereupon the said Winnifred Abden is ordered to give security for the payment of the several Officers fees due by occasion of the premises aforesaid upon the Indictment aforesaid thereupon a certain George Brown of Somerset County Bricklayer & at heren Court in his proper person acknowledged himself Indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietor in the sum of five pounds Sterling of his body goods or Chattell Lands or tenements to be made a Lien to the use of the Officers of Somerset County Court that hath any fees upon the Indictment aforesaid.

If it happen that the said George Brown do not pay and satisfy unto the several Officers their fees due by occasion of the premises aforesaid upon the Indictment aforesaid.
