Justices for the County of Somerset the above named Robert Bolton and made oath on the Holy Evangelist of Almighty God that the above account is a Just and true copy of the account stated settled and signed by Whixem Cragger in his book and that he hath not since received any part or parcels thereof nor any satisfaction or security for the same to the best of his knowledge December 13th 1734 Sworn before me

And the afo^r Whixham Cragger by George Douglas his attorney comes and defends the force & injury when & and prays leave thereof to be made hereuntil next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid Robert he real's &c

All which said next Court to wit the Eighteenth day of March Ann^o: Dom^o: One thousand seven hundred and thirty four came against the afo^r Robert Bolton as the afo^r Whixham Cragger by their attorney afo^r and thereupon the said Whixham Cragger as before defends the force & injury when & and saith that he cannot gainsay the action afo^r of the afo^r Robert Bolton nor can he say but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the afo^r Robert Bolton above against him hath complained and as to the damage of the same Robert by him by occasion of the premises in that part sustained the same Whixham saith and confesseth that the afo^r Robert hath sustained damages by occasion of the premises beyond his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part apposed to three pounds one Shilling and three pence current money of Maryland and not more and because the afo^r Robert denies not this but the same allegation confesseth to be true prays Judgment for those damages above confessed together with his costs and charges aforesaid to him to be adjudged &c

Therefore by consent of the parties afo^r it is considered that the aforesaid Robert Bolton recover against the afo^r Whixham Cragger his damages afo^r to the afo^r three pounds one Shilling and three pence current money of Maryland in form afo^r confessed as ab^o. Two hundred and forty pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges afo^r to the same Robert Bolton by the Court here and consent of the parties afo^r and adjudged and the afo^r defendant in mercy &c

And whereupon the said Duncan by Geo: Douglas his attorney complains that whereas the said Edmond on the first day of November Ann^o: Dom^o: Seventeen hundred and thirty four at the County aforesaid was indebted to the said Duncan in the sum of Six pounds fifteen Shillings current money of Maryland
