Indebted unto his Lordships the Right Honble in twenty pounds Sterling good and Lawfull money of England of his goods and Chattells Lands and tenements to be made and Levied for the Use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors If it happen that the said John White do not make his personall appearance before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be hold at dividing Week the third Tuesday of August then next and do not answer unto his said Lordship of and concerning a certain Information against him exhibited for excessive luxury, and do not stand and abide the Judgment of the Court thereupon and do depart the same Court without Leave &c

William Walton Junr appears according to recognizance entered into of the Court for his appearance and good behaviour to the Court, whereupon the said William Walton's appearance is recorded and he and his security accordingly discharged &c

Thereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said Michael Redding if he to answer &c. and afterwards to wit the seventeenth day of June and do one thousand seven hundred and thirty five before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset where hold at dividing week in the same County came the said Michael Redding in his proper person under custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County and being by the said Sheriff led to the bar is upon instantly demanded how he would acquit himself of the premises and above upon him ^{into whose custody before that time he was committed for the cause aforesaid} he answered that he is not willful to offend with his Lordships the Lord proprietor but puts himself upon the favor of the Court and submits with a protestation of his Innocency &c

Whereupon all and singular the premises by the Court here seen heard and fully understood - It is considered by the Court here that the said Michael Redding pay unto his Lordship the Lord proprietor for his fine by the Court hereupon him imposed for and by occasion of the premises aforesaid whereof in form aforesaid he is bound thirty Shillings Current money & that the said Michael Redding be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine aforesaid &c
Whereupon the said Michael Redding is ordered to give security for the payment of the several Officers fees due by occasion of the premises aforesaid and for his good behaviour and appearance at any Court next &c whereupon Francis Carter of Somerset County hath present ^{to the Court} undertaken for
