 that you attach any, of the goods Chattles rights or Credits of Thomas Gray late of Somerset
 County March^t. if they shall be found in your bailiwick to the Value of seven pounds, seven
 shillings and eleven pence Currant money of Maryland and thirteen hundred pounds of tobacco
 and when you have the same attached or any part thereof the, same in, your custody, safe-
 keep so that you have the same before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at
 dividing, week the third Tuesday of June next then and there to be condemned according to act
 of assembly to and for the use of a certain William McClemmey unless the said, Thomas Gray
 by himselfe or his attorney shall appear and answer unto the said William McClemmey in
 plea of trespass upon the case &c. according to Law and that by good and Lawfull men of your
 bailiwick you make known unto the persons or persons in whose hands you make the same
 attachment that he she or they be and appear before our Justices of our County Court to be held
 as afo^r to shew cause if any he she or they have why the, same goods Chattles rights or Credits
 so attached in his ^{her} or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made
 according to act of assembly (in such case made and provided) of to him her or them it shall
