Thereupon Francis Allen of Somerset County Gent. present herein Court undertook for the said William McGemney according to act of assembly that in case the said Thomas Gray do at any time within a year and a day appear and make all or any part of the said Thomas William McGemney's Claim against him appear to be satisfied or otherwise to have been undue before the laying of the attachment afo that then the said William McGemney shall make restitution unto him the said Thomas Gray of all or such part thereof as shall appear ^{to be} undue or that he the said Francis Allen will do the same for him.

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here that the afo Sum of Six shillings pt. of the Sum attached and Confessed be condemned in the hands of the said Edward William, and the afo Sum of fifty Shillings Curr. money part of the Sum attached and Confessed be condemned in the hands of Thomas Shuter and the afo flat of the value of fifty Shillings Curr. money be condemned as the goods and Chattels Rights and Credits of the afo Thomas Gray towards Satisfying unto the said William McGemney as well the afo Sum of seven pound seven Shillings & Eleven pence Curr. money as also all Costs and Charges answering upon the writ of attachment afo and that the said Wm. McGemney have thereof Execution according to act of assembly &c. Edward William & Thomas Shuter Garnished a. afo voluntarily takes their oath that they had not more of the Effects of the Gray than they have Confessed Likewise Robert Collier an other of the Garnishers voluntarily takes his oath that he hath none of the Effects of the said Thomas Gray in his hands &c. Richard Phillips appears & departs &c.
