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to me directed to the Justices within mentioned I Certifie that on the fourteenth day this Instant I have attached in the hands of William Whittington of the goods and Chattels Rights and Credits of John Donelson for the tax of ~~the said Donelson~~ for the use of Rep^t. Samuel Hopkins to the value of fifteen pounds Curr^t. money and in the hands of Gregrave Turville to the value of Nine pounds fifteen shillings and ten pence Curr^t. money of Maryland and further Certifie that by John Doe and Richard Roe good & Lawfull men of my Bailiwick that they be & appear at the time and place within Contained and I further Certifie to the said Justices that the said John Doe not at this time any other goods Chattels Rights or Credits in my Bailiwick by which he may atone —
so answer Joraght McCarter Sh^r

Whereupon the said Gregrave Turville Garnishee of the said John Donelson appears in his proper person and saith that he cannot gainway but that he hath of the Rights and Credits of the said John Donelson to the value of the said Nine pounds fifteen shillings and ten pence Curr^t. money of Maryland so as is attached and not more nor can he say but that the same ought to be condemned in his hands for the tax of the said Samuel Hopkins as of the Rights and Credits of the said John Donelson which the said John Doe doth not gainway —

Whereupon the said Samuel Hopkins by his attorney doth pray that upon giving security according to act of assembly in such case provided that the said Sum of Nine pounds fifteen shillings and ten pence Curr^t. money so as is attached and Confessed by the said Gregrave Turville as of the Rights and Credits of the said John Donelson may be condemned in the hands of the said Gregrave Turville toward Satisfying unto the said Samuel Hopkins his Damages and all Cost and Charges accruing on the writt of attachment and that —

Thereupon Francis Allen of Somerset County Gent^l present herem Court undertakes for the said Samuel Hopkins according to act of assembly in such case made and provided that if in case the said John Donelson do at any time within a year and a day appear and make all or any part of the said Samuel Hopkins's Claim against him appear to be satisfied or otherwise to have been undue before the Laying of the attachment and that when the said Samuel Hopkins shall make restitution unto him the said John Donelson of all or such part thereof as shall be made appear to be undue &c. or that he the said Francis Allen will do the same for him —

Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here that the said Sum of nine pounds fifteen shillings and ten pence Curr^t. money of Maryland so as is attached and Confessed be condemned in the hands of the said Gregrave Turville as of the Rights and Credits of the said John Donelson toward Satisfying unto the said Samuel Hopkins as well his Damages as also all Cost and Charges accruing upon the attachment and that he have thereof Satisfaction — Likewise the said William Whittington had as is by Francis Allen his attorney appears & Imparles —
