 the presents of the complainant or deft. if any touching the truth or Remembrance of their
 knowledge or any thing that may Relate to the cause aforesaid and that reducing the severall
 depositions into writing you send the same together with this our Commission under your or any
 three or two of your or any three or two of your hands and seals to us to our Court Court of
 Somerset with all convenient speed Witness John Smith Gent. one of our Justices of our said
 Court the twentieth day of March Anno Dom one thousand seven hundred and thirty five
 On the Backside of the foregoing Commission it was thus Endorsed viz June the 10th 1736 This day
