Stevenson orphans of W^m Stevenson dec^d in the full and just sum of forty pounds four shillings
and ten pence current money to be paid unto the said William Stevenson the younger his heir
Ex^r Adm^r or assigns to the which payment well and truly to be made and done we bind our
selves our and either of our heirs, Ex^r and adm^r for the whole and in the whole jointly and
severally, firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals and dated this 16 day of June Anno Domini 1736

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the Commisary Gen^l hath
transmitted unto this Court the Accompt of the estate of W^m Stevenson dec^d wherein it is
found that there is B^d due to the above said orphans the sum of twenty pounds four shillings and
eleven pence current money if therefore the above said John Deal Junr. Samuel Bratton and
John Deal sen^r or any or either of them or any or either of their heirs Ex^r or adm^r do and shall
well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the a^d orphans the a^d sum of twenty pounds four
shillings and eleven pence current money of Maryland According to act of assembly
where he shall arrive at full age to receive the same &c then the above obligation
to be void and of none effect otherwise to remain in full force and vertue &c

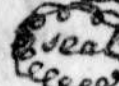
