June next to satisfy John White of Dorchester late of Somerset County planter of Six  
hundred and fifty five pounds of tobacco which to the same John White in the Court before  
the Justices thereof at Dwiding Green by direction of the same Justices were adjudged  
for his Costs and Charges which he sustained in a certain plea of trespass upon the case by the said Jos  
Britt against the same John White in the same Court Impetrate according to the form of the sta-  
tute thereof made and provided against parties plaintiffs which their Writts in such manner  
of pleas do not prosecute or in the same should be concluded whereof he is Committed &c

All which said third Tuesday of June to wit the fifteenth day of the same month and  
Dow One thousand Seven hundred and thirty six being the day of the return of the said Writ  
Came the said John White for his own proper person and the Sheriff of Somerset County to whom  
the foregoing writ was directed Likewise Cometh and the said John Britt being Led to the Bar

at the prayer of the said John White the said John Britt is Committed into the Custody of the Sheriff
