Whereupon the said Thomas Fletcher by his attorney aff prays that for as much as he has employed with the Law in order to an attachment he may have Judgment against the said Walter Godd for his damages and by way of attachment according to act of assembly &c. Whereupon for that it seems to the Court here that the said Thomas Fletcher has comply with the Law as alleged

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here that the said Thomas Fletcher recover against the said Walter Godd the Sum of two thousand and Eighty Eight and one quarter pounds of Tobacco his damages by Quasion of the premises and as also all Costs and Charges by the said p^lff^r laid out and expounded about his suit by way of attachment against the goods Chattels Rights or Credits of the said Walter Godd according to act of assembly in such case made and provided &c.

John Crapper } John Crapper of the County and province abovesaid planter was summoned to answer unto William Crapper of force that he render unto him twenty pounds of Maryland Cur. which to him he owes and unjustly detains &c.

And whereupon the said William by Francis Allen his attorney saith that whereas the said John the ninth day of march One thousand Seven hundred and thirty One at the County of Somerset and within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain Writing Obligatory which the said William with the seal of the said John Signed herunto sent brings the date whereof is the same day and year did acknowledge himself to be bound unto the said William in the sum of Twenty pounds to be paid to the same William when he should be thereunto required yet the said John tho' often Required the said twenty pounds to the said William hath not rendered but the same to him himself, to render both day and date doth deny and unjustly detain to the damage of the said William of ten pounds Cur. money of Maryland and thereupon he brings Suit &c.

And the said John Crapper in his own proper person Cometh and Defendeth the force and Injury when &c. and prays Leave thereto to dispute hereunto the next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the said William here also &c.
