Rachelle Trueman late of all hallows parish in the County of Squinter the last day of february in the year of Our Lord God Seventeen hundred and thirty five at the County and parish aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court did Commit fornication with a certain person to the Jurors of unknown and did permit the same unknown person then and there to have carnall knowledge of her Body and to begett there of thers abastard Child on the Body of her the same Rachelle to the high displeasur of almighty God to the worse Example of all others in such case offending contrary to the peace of the said Lord proty that now is his good luke and Government and against the act of asembly in such case lately made and provided &c. —

Took Oath &c. — On the Backside of the foregoing Bill of Indictment it was Indorsed Billa Vera Edmund Hough foreman . . . Thereupon Command was given to the Just of Somerset County that he should take the afo Rachelle Trueman to answer &c. and afterwards to writt the fifteenth Day of June aforesaid. One thousand seven hundred & thirty six came hereto Court before the Justices Heres of aforesaid great the afo supposed Rachelle Trueman, but forasmuch as it doth appear to the Court heres that there is no such person as Rachelle Trueman &c. Therefore it is Considered by the Court heres that the Indictment afo & the proceeding thereon be quashed & that the afo supposed Rachelle Trueman be quiett &c. & goe heres without day &c. —

Mr. George Dashiell is allowed One thousand pounds of tobacco she bringing in the best piece of Linnas according to act of asembly in such case made and provided &c. —

Anna Bella Mitchell allowed Eight hundred pounds of tobacco she bringing in the second best piece of Linnas according to act of asembly in such case made and provided &c. —

Cap: Edward Rowland allowed five hundred pounds of tobacco she bringing in the third best piece of Linnas according to act of asembly in such case made and provided &c. —

Upon the petition of Robert Kamey a poor Indigent person for something to be allowed him for his support in his poor weak condition: upon Reading of the petition afo the Justices agree with Mr. Robert King to find and provide for the said Robert Kamey all such necessary both in Clothing and provisions or any other necessary as may be sufficient to support the said Kamey in this his weak condition untill now and Court next, and that the said King should then be allowed for the same &c. —
