All which said next Court to wit the sixteenth day of March and Dowd One thousand Seven hundred and thirty five came againe as well the aff Thomas Lambden as the aff Thomas Billings and Thomas Gardner by their attorneys aff and whereupon the said Thomas Billings and Thomas Gardner pray further Leave ^{thereof} to Impare here until next Court and they have it and the same day is given to the aff Thomas Lambden here also

All which said next Court to wit the fifteenth day of June and Dowd One thousand seven hundred and thirty six came againe as well the aff Thomas Lambden as the aff Thomas Billings and Thomas Gardner by their attorneys aff and whereupon the said Thomas Billings and Thomas Gardner by their attorney aff defend the fore & injury when ~~it~~ and protesting that he the said Thomas Gardner is not Executor of the said William Smith for plea they say that the said William Smith in his Life time did not assume upon himselfe in manner and form as the said Thomas Lambden above against them hath complained and of this they putt themselves upon the country and the aff Thomas Gardner and Thomas Billings by Leave of the Court here and according to the form of the statute in that case lately made and provided protesting that he the said Thomas Gardner is not, Executor of the testament and last will of the said William Smith protesting also that he the said William Smith in his life time did not assume upon himselfe in manner and form as the said Thomas Lambden above against them hath complained for plea that nevertheless the said Thomas Gardner and Thomas Billings severally say that the said Thomas Lambden his action aff against them the said Thomas Gardner and Thomas Billings have fully administered all the goods and chattels which were of the aff William Smith at the time of his death and that they or either of them have no Goods or Chattels which were of the aff William Smith at the time of his death in their hands to be Administred nor had at the day of the impetration of ^{the} originall writt of him the said Thomas Lambden nor ever afterwards and this they are ready to verify, wherefore they pray Judgment if the said Thomas (Lambden)
