

Robert Warren if he to answer & after ward to witt the seventeenth day of August anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty six before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset now here hold at dividing Beek in and for the same County came the said Robert Warren in his proper person and had a hearing of the Indictment aforesaid who thereupon says that he is guilty thereof and is willing to pay his fine for the fact aforesaid whereupon all & singular the premises by the Court here seen heard & fully understood Wherefore it is considered by the Court that the aforesaid Robert Warren pay unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary for his fine by the Court hereupon him imposed for and by conviction of the premises aforesaid ^{whereof in form aforesaid Court} three pounds current money of Maryland for the use of the County aforesaid and that the said Robert Warren be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine aforesaid Whereupon the said Robert Warren present here in Court is ordered to give security to save and keep undisputed the Justices of Somerset County Court their Successors for the time being from all Costs Charges troubles and Burthens that might accrue by means of the Birth & of the said Child &c

Thereupon the said Robert Warren with Joseph Hall of Somerset County planter his security both present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the sum of fifty pounds Sterling of their several goods & and Chattels Lands and tenements to the use of the County of Somerset to be made & served if it happen that the said Robert Warren his heirs & assigns or any of them do and shall not from time to time, and at all times forever hereafter, acquit discharge and save harmless as well the Justices of Somerset County Court, for the time being, and their Successors, as also the Inhabitants of the same County, from all Costs Charges troubles whatsoever for or by reason of the birth, maintenance, nourishing, and bringing up, of the said Child, and of and from all other suits Costs Charges Burthens troubles, and demands whatsoever touching or concerning of the same &c

 to the Jurors aforesaid unknown and did permit the same unknown person there and thereto have carnal
 knowledge of her body and to beget there and there a bastard Child on the body of her the same Eliz^d
