: and seven hundred and thirty six before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset now here held at Dividing Creek in the same County came the said Eliz. Waller in her proper person and had charging of the said indictment aff who thereupon says that she is guilty thereof and is willing to pay her fine for the said aff and makes Oath that certain toward Hergo is the father of the Child she stands Indicted for whereupon all and Singular the premises by the Court here being seen heard and fully understood.

Therefore it is Considered by the Court here that the aff Eliz. Waller pay unto this Lordship the Lord Proprietary for her fine by the Court hereupon her Imposed for and by Execution of the premises of whereof in sum aff she is found guilty Thirly Shillings curr. money of Maryland for the use of the County of and that the said Eliz. Waller be taken to Satisfactionis said Lordship of the fine aff. Whereupon the said Eliz. Waller is ordered to give security to save and keep Indemnified the Justices of Somerset County Court and their Successors for the same being from all costs charges Troubles and Burthens that might accrue by means of the birth of the said Child. Thereupon the said Eliz. Waller with Humphrey Chapman Clerk of Somerset County of Court her security both present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the sum of Thirly pounds Sterling good and Lawfull money of England of their Several goods and Chattels Lands and tenements to the use of the County of Somerset to be made and levied if it happen that the said Eliz. Waller her husband and child or any of them do and shall not from time to time and at all times forever hereafter acquit discharge and have harmes as well the Justices of Somerset County Court for the time being and their Successors as also the Inhabitants of the same County from all Costs Charges and trouble whatsoever from by reason of the birth, maintenance nourishing, and bringing up of the said Child and of and from all other such Costs, Charges, Burthens Troubles and demands whatsoever touching or concerning of the same. Likewise the said Eliz. Waller is ordered by the Court to give security for the payment of the several Officers fees due by Execution of the premises aff whereupon the aforesaid Humphrey Chapman present here in Court acknowledged him self Indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in ten pounds Sterling to be levied of his body goods or Chattels Lands and tenements to the use of the said Court if it happen that the said Humphrey Chapman do not pay unto the several Officers their fees due by means of the premises aff
