hundred thirty and six a^{ts} at the parish a^{ts} in the County a^{ts} within the T^{er}rit^{or}y of this Court in and upon a certain Thomas Hargis of the same County a^{ts} planter in the peace of God and of the same Lord Proprietary then and there being with force and arms an assault did make and the same Thomas then and there did beat wound and evilly treat so that of his life it was greatly despaired and other harms to him then and there did to the great damage of the same Thomas and against the peace of the said Lord Proprietary that now is his good rule and Government &c. Whereupon the same attorney of the said Lord Proprietary prayeth the advice of the Court here in the premises and that due process of law in this part against the a^{ts} Nehemiah may be made to answer unto the same Lord Proprietary of and upon the premises &c.

Thereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said Nehemiah Holland ist to answer &c. and afterwards to wit the seventeenth day of August a^{nt}. 1736. One thousand Seven hundred & thirty six before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset now to be hold at Dividing ^{Crack} in the same County came the said Nehemiah in his proper person attending to a certain Recognizance by him and his security before acknowledged and had a hearing of the Information a^{ts} and saith that of the premises a^{ts} he is guilty thereof &c.

Whereupon all and singular the premises by the Court has been heard and fully understood &c.

Therefore it is considered by the Court that the a^{ts} Nehemiah Holland pay unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary for his fine by the Court laid upon him imposed for and by occasion of the he a^{ts} and assault a^{ts} whereof in fine a^{ts} he is found ten Shillings Curr. money of Maryland and that the said Nehemiah Holland be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine a^{ts}.

Whereupon the said Nehemiah Holland is ordered to give good security for his good behavior and appearance before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dividing Crack the third Tuesday of November next &c.

Thereupon the said Nehemiah Holland with Benjamin Holland late of Somerset County planter his security both present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the sum of ten pounds Sterling each of their goods and Chattell Lands and tenements severally to be made and levied to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors. If it happen that the said Nehemiah Holland do not make his personal appearance before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dividing Crack in the same County the third Tuesday of November ^{next} and do not answer unto his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary of and concerning such matters and things as should be then and there objected against him or his
