his proper person and acknowledged himself indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary  
in the Sum of five pounds sterling good and Lawfull money of England of his goods and Chattels,  
Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heir and Successor to be made and  
Levied. If it happen that the said Elizabeth Daugh do not make her personall appearance  
before the Justices of this Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dwidning Creek  
in the same County the third Tuesday of November next and do not then and there give such evi-  
dence as she suspects against the said John Millicott for and concerning his being Suspected of felonious-  
ly Stealing one hogg the goods and Chattels of a certain Matthew Parkmore and do depart the same  
Court without Leave &c.
