said, Thomas saith he is worse and hath damage to the value of twenty pounds current money
of Maryland and thereupon he brings suit &c ———— *Edgar &c. John Doe &c. &c.*

At which said Third Tuesday of August to witt the Seventh day of the same month and Done one
