On the backside of the foregoing Bill of Indictment it was thus Endorsed viz True Bill of ^{the} ~~the~~
welfare of the said County - - afterwards to wit the seventeenth day of June and Dow. One thousand seven hundred
and thirty five before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset now here hold at Dividing Creek
and for the same County came the aforesaid John Shiles in his proper person according to a certain Plea qui-
tance by him and his security before acknowledged and being by the Sheriff of the County aforesaid set to
the Bar had absconding of the Indictment and who says that he is not guilty thereof and of this he puts
himself upon the Country and William Goldborough Gent his said Lordships attorney and who for
