Memorandum the 25th by George Douglas his attorney sued out his
Lordships writt of attachment the tenor whereof followeth in these
words following vizt Somerset Charles absolute Lord and Gro-

prietary of the Province of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. To the
Sheriff of Somerset County greeting we command you that you attach any of the good Chattles
Rights or Credits of John Donelson late of Somerset County Mariner if they shall be found in
your Bailiwick to the value of seven pounds thirteen shillings and five pence Curr^t money of Mary-
land and twenty one pounds one shilling and four pence halfe Boston money and seven hundred pounds
of tobacco and when you have the same attached any part thereof the same in your custody safe keep
so that you have the same before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at dioding
Creek the Tuesday of August next then and there to be condemned according to act of assembly to
and for the use of a certain Samuel Hopkins unless the said John Donelson or by himself or his
attorney shall appear and answer unto the said Samuel Hopkins in a plea of trespass upon
the case &c. According to law and that by good and lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make
known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same ~~attach-~~ attach-
ment that he she or they be and appear before our Justices of our County Court to be held as afo^r to
show cause if any he she have why the same goods Chattles Rights or Credits so attached in his
her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to act
of assembly in such case made and provided yf to him her or them it shall seem meet and how
you shall Execute this writt that you make known unto our said Justices at the day and place
afo^r and have you then and there this writt witnessed Robert King Gent. Chief Justice of our said
Court the nineteenth day of June in the twenty second year of our Dominion &c. And Done one
thousand seven hundred thirty and six

All which said Third Tuesday ~~last~~ day of August is with the seventeenth day of the same
month anno. Dom. One thousand seven hundred and thirty Six being the day of the return
of the same writt Cometh the same Samuel Hopkins by his attorney afo^r and the Sheriff
of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writt was directed Likewise Cometh and made the return
thereof to the Court here Dated in these words following vizt - By virtue of the within
Writt to me directed to the Justices within mentioned I certify that I have attached in the hands
of Capt Luke Morris as the goods and Chattles of Capt John Donelson to the value of eight
pounds ten shillings for the use of Capt Samuel Hopkins which further appears by a schedule
herunto annexed and I further certify that by William Townsend and John Doe good &
Lawfull men of my Bailiwick that I made known unto the above named Luke Morris
that he be and appear at the time and place within contained so answer Jos: W. Master that
