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Courtly to wit Joseph Mylster Gentleman at the same day returned that the said John Donaldson is not found &c. Whereupon the said James and Adam Muir by their attorney and prayer that forasmuch as they have complied with the Law in order to an attachment they may have Judgment against the said John Donaldson for their debt &c by way of attachment according to act of assembly &c. Whereupon for that it seems to the Court here that the said James and Adam Muir has complied with the Law as alleged &c. —

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here that the said James and Adam Muir recover against the said John Donaldson their debt as also all Costs Charges and — ~~damages sustained by reason of the detention~~ of the said debt by the Court here of them apart & judged by way of attachment against the goods Chattle Rights and Credits of the said John Donaldson according to act of assembly in such case made and provided &c. —

And Whereupon the same Levin Gale by William Bechingham his attorney complained that whereas the said William Wye the eleventh day of December in the year of our Lord seventeen hundred and thirty five at Somerset County (he the same William Wye then and there residing and using commerce) according to the custom of Merchants and others (the contrary whereof in the memory of man is not used and approved made and with his proper hand subscribed his certain Inland Bill bearing date the day and year aforesaid and to ascertain Captain Joseph Macclester Sheriff of Somerset County Maryland directed by which same Bill the said William Wye then and there did require the said Joseph Macclester to pay unto Captain John Shapleigh or order the full Quantity of six thousand four hundred and sixty eight pounds of tobacco convenient in Somerset Parish in Maryland upon demand according to law and to place the same to the Account of the said William Wye which same Inland Bill afterwards to wit the same eleventh day of December in the year aforesaid at the County aforesaid the said six thousand four hundred and sixty eight pounds or any part thereof in no sort satisfied or paid being by the said John Shapleigh to the said Levin Gale was assigned by which same assignment the same John Shapleigh the day and year aforesaid at the County aforesaid according to the custom of Merchants in —
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
