And the aff William Wye in his own proper person someth and defendeth the force &
Injury when &c. and saith and saith that he cannot gain say the action aff of the aff Levi
nor but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the aff Levi above
against him hath complained and as to the damage of the same Levi by him by occasion
of the premises in that part sustained the same William saith and Confesseth that the
aff Levi has sustained damages by occasion of the premises beyond his costs and Charges
by him about his suit in that part appoyed to Sixty four pounds thirteen Shillings and
Eight pence Curr. money of Maryland and not more and because the aff Levi deny not
this but the same allegation Confesseth to be true pray Judgm for those damages first above.
Confessed to gether with his costs and Charges aff to him to be adjudged &c. —

Therefore by Consent of the parties aff it is considered by the Court here that the aff Levi
Gale recover against the aff William Wye his damages aff to the aff Sixty four pounds thirteen
shillings and eight pence Curr. money of Maryland by the same William in form aff Confessed
as also four hundred and twenty pounds of tobacco for his costs and
Charges aff to the same Levi at his request by the Court here by Consent of the parties aff
adjudged and the aff doth in many &c.
