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At which said next Court to wit the seventeenth day of August and Do. One thousand seven hundred and thirty six came again as well the ^{ap} John Hollows as the ^{ap} Thomas Fletcher by their attorneys. And whereupon the same Thomas Fletcher as before defended the force and Injury when ^{he} said says that he did not assume upon himself in such manner and form as the ^{ap} John above against him do the Complaint and of this he puts himself upon the Country and the said John Likewise.

Thereupon it is Commanded the Sheriff of Somerset County that immediately he should cause to come here before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset now sitting at Twidning Creek in the same County twelve ^{by whom} and who neither ^{to} to recognize ^{because} as well ^{he}. And afterwards immediately came those of the Jury ^{he}. and the Jurors of that same Jury by Joseph Maulester Gent. Sheriff of the County ^{ap} to this Impannelled being called came to wit. Thomas Dixon John Alkison George Full, Joseph Gray William Mill, George Howard Joseph Hall, John Jones Robert Givan John Webb John Davis Adam Spence who to say the truth of the premises ^{ap} being duly elected tried and sworn upon their Oaths do say that the ^{ap} Thomas Fletcher did assume upon himself in such manner and form as the ^{ap} John follows above against him hath Complaind and ascerted the Damages of the same John Hollows by occasion of the non performance of the promise and assumption ^{ap} beyond his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part appoyed to Eight hundred pounds of Tobacco and for his Costs and Charges to One pound of Tobacco.

Therefore it is Considered that the ^{ap} John Hollows recover against the ^{ap} Thomas Fletcher his Damages ^{ap} by the Jurors ^{ap} in form ^{ap} ascerted as also
