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Law and that by good and Lawfull men of my Bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before our Justices of our County Court to be held as aforesaid to show cause if any he she or they have why the same goods Chattels rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to act of assembly in such case made and Provided if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall execute this writt that you make known unto our said Justices at the day and Place aforesaid and have you then and there this writt Witness John Smith Gent One of our Justices of our said Court the twentieth day of March and Year One thousand Seven hundred and thirty five.

At which said third Tuesday of June to wit the thirteenth day of the same month and Year One thousand Seven hundred and thirty six being the day of the return of the said writt Cometh the said William Maulemney by George Douglas his attorney and the Sheriff of Somerset County to wit Joseph Maulester Gent at the said day Returned to the Justices of the Sheriff's County Court of Somerset Advised and said that by virtue of writt aforesaid on the twentieth day of May Seventeen hundred & thirty six did attach at the County aforesaid for the use of William Maulemney as the rights & Credits of Thomas Gray in the hands of John Waters the money and to be in the writt aforesaid mentioned and by Joshua Merrick & John Doe his coort and Lawfull men of my Bailiwick I did make known unto the said John Waters that he should be and appear at the time & place within contained as by the within precept I was commanded &c.

And the said John Waters by Robert Jenkins Henry his attorney comes and prays Leave to appear hereunto the next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the said William Maulemney here also &c.

At which said next Court to wit the seventeenth day of August and Year One thousand Seven hundred & thirty six came againe as well the said William Maulemney as the said John Waters by their attorneys aforesaid and whereupon the said John Waters says that he cannot pay any but that he hath of the rights and Credits of the said Thomas Gray to the value of four hundred pounds of to be and not more and because the said William Maulemney denies not this but the same allegation suspects to be true prays that the same four hundred pounds of to be may be condemned in the hands of the said John Waters as of the rights and Credits of the said Thomas Gray and Likewise prays Judgment for his costs and Charges by him in this part
