Late of Somerset County Merchant if they shall be found in your Bailiwick to the value of seven pounds seven Shillings and eleven pence Curr. money of Maryland and thirteen hundred pounds of tobacco & when you have the same attached or any part thereof of the same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing week the third Tuesday of June next then and there to be condemned according to act of assembly to and for the use of a certain William Mardenmay unless the said Thomas Gray by himself or his attorney shall appear and answer unto the said William Mardenmay in plea of trespass upon the fact according to Law and that by good and Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before our Justices of our County Court to be held as aforesaid to show Cause if any he she or they have why the same goods Chattels light or Credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to act of assembly in such Case made and provided if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall Execute this writt that you make known unto our said Justices at the Day and place aforesaid and have you then and there this writt Witness John Smith Gent. One of our Justices of our said Court the fourth day of March Anno Domini One thousand seven hundred & thirty six.

Att which said Third Tuesday of June to witt the fifteenth day of the same month and said One thousand seven hundred & thirty six being the day of the return of the same Writt came the said William Mardenmay by his attorney ^{George Douglas} Esq and the Sheriff of Somerset County to witt Joseph Maulester Gent at the same Day returned to the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at dividing week that by virtue of the Writt aforesaid that he on the twenty eighth of May seventeen hundred & thirty six did attach for the use of the said William Mardenmay of the rights and Credits of the said Thomas Gray in the hands of Richard Phillips the money and tobacco in the writt aforesaid mentioned and by John Doe & Rich Roe good & Lawfull men of his Bailiwick he did make known unto the said Richard Phillips that he should be & appear at the time and
