any three or two of you at some time and place as to you or any three or two of you shall seem convenient you meet on the aforesaid Land (you first haven taken your oaths on the holy Evangelist of almighty god according to Act of assembly in such case made and provided and there cause to come before you or any three or two of you all such evidences as shall be to you or any three or two of you nominated by the said complainant or defendant if any and that you or any three or two of you examine them upon their Corporall oaths to be by you or any three or two of you administered on the holy evangelist of almighty God in the presents of the complainant or defendant if any touching the truth or Remembrance of there knowledge or any thing that may relate to the cause aforesaid and that reducing the severall depositions into writing you send the same together with ^{their} our Commissioners under you or any three or two of your hands and seals to us to our County Court of Somerset with all convenient speed Witness John Smith Gent one of our Justices of our said Court the twelveth day of March in the twenty first year of our Dominion V: Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty five

on the backside of the foregoing Commission it was written as followeth Vnt Be it Remembred that on the Sixth day of August 1736 personally appeared before me the Subscriber one of his Lordships Justices of the peace for the County of Somerset Thomas Waller and Peter Collier and were sworn according to an act of assembly in that case made and provided to examine such evidences as to them did appear upon their Corporall oaths of their Remembrance relating to the bounds of a tract of Land called Genezee with us on the day and year above written --- Jas. Parklife ---

Now know all this day to witt the Seventeenth day of August Anno Domini One thousand Seven and thirty six came herunto Court Thomas Waller and Peter Collier two of the Gentlemen mentioned in the above mentioned Commission and made their return thereto to the Court here with the following Depositions thereto annexed Vnt By virtue of a Commission from the Worshipfull Justices of Somerset directed to us the Subscribers hereunto annexed we the said Subscribers after given notice according to the directions of an act of assembly in that case made and provided did meet on the aforesaid Land called Genezee and there and there did cause to come before us the following deponents and they the said deponents being sworn do say as followeth. ---

Richard Holland aged 55 years or thereabouts deposes upon Oath that about Twenty years past the said Holland came to the house of Edmund Prappers and the said Prappers proposed to the said Holland that they would goe and seeke for the first bounder of the said Genezee and
