Thomas Bartlett of Somerset County aged about fifty four years came sworn
as aforesaid deposeth and saith that he hath severall times been informed by Richard Nicholson

deponents father now dead and by old William Caines now also dead that the first bounder of tract
of Land containing two hundred acres belonging to one Ridgely stood on the point mentioned
and described in the deposition of the said Adams and that by the description given the deponent
by the said several persons of the said Bounder he verily believeth that the Slump men-
tioned in the said Reverend Mr Adams deposition is the Slump of said tree

Returne that by vertue of the Writ aforesaid he had taken the body of the aforesaid Daniel
Ringrose whose body before his decease was interred at Holme and placed up in a howitt of
