For as much as William Maul Dorman of Somerset County planter had not burnt ^{so much} tobacco as by Law he was obliged to burn but was willing to pay his fine for the same Wherefore it is considered by the Court here that the said William Maul Dorman pay unto his Lordship for his fine for and by occasion of the premises ^{of} twenty Shillings Court money of Maryland and that he be taken ^{to}

John Wheeler late of Somerset County planter being summoned for to appear at this Court to answer his not burning tobacco according to Law in such case provided ^{of} and for as much as it doth appear to the Court here that the said John Wheeler hath not burnt so much tobacco as by Law he was obliged to burn ^{of} Wherefore it is considered by the Court here that the said John Wheeler pay unto his Lordship for his fine for and by occasion of the premises ^{of} twenty Shillings Court money of Maryland and that though the said John Wheeler is ordered by the Court here to give security for the payment of the fine ^{of} and the several officers fees due on the premises ^{of} but for want thereof
