Since that time hath very much wasted the said Estate so that your petitioner is very likely to be a great sufferer by means of his being such her Deputy - And the said John Donelson ~~had~~
by those severall months past left and departed Government and probably will never returne so that your petitioner is in all probability likely to be the sole sufferer by means
of the premises. In tender consideration whereof your petitioner prayeth that the said —
Katherine may be directed by this Court to give to your petitioner sufficient Counter Security to indemnify him by means of the premises or otherwise relieve your petitioner according to the
directions of the act of Assembly in that case lately made and provided and your petitioner shall

Thereupon command was given to the Sheriff of Somersel County that he
should summon the said Katherine Stewart so that she might appear here immediately
in Court to answer the petition of the afo Robert Hodge — — — — —

Whereupon afterwards to wit the seventeenth day of Augt and anno. One thousand Seven
hundred and Ninety six came hereto Court as well the afo Robert Hodge as the afo Katherine Stewart
in their proper persons according to the Subpoena of and his petition of being read and
heard and the premises considered and mature deliberation thereupon had. Whereupon the
said Katherine Stewart is ordered to give the said Robert Hodge good and sufficient Security
to save and keep him indemnified as by the petition afo is prayed, but the said Katherine
Stewart making it appear to the Court here that she is not able to give such security as before
directed, but that she the said Katherine is willing to surrender or deliver up unto the
said Hodge all the Estate of the said William Stewart that she hath in her hands that doth
belong unto the children of the said William Stewart. Thereupon the said Order is appoin't
died Round and Wm Gray of Manors of Somersel County hath to appraise the Estate of
the said William Stewart in the hands of the afo Katherine Stewart unto the afo Robt Hodge but
if it should happen hereafter upon the said Robt Hodge making application unto
the said Katherine for the said Estate, and the said Katherine refuse to deliver the same —
that then the said Robert Hodge appear before a magistrate and make affidavit of the said
Katherine's Refusal, that the said Magistrate upon the request of said Hodge to do his
want to the best of his power and thereby directing him to give attache to the said Katherine in
order to possess the said Hodge with the Estate of the said William Stewart. — — — — —
