in forty pounds Sterling and the aforesaid Robert Melvill and James Breeman in twenty pounds Sterling each
good and Lawfull money of England of their severall goods and Chattels Lands & Tenements of every
of them to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors to be made and Levied.

If it happen that the aforesaid Thomas Lambden do not make his personall appearance before the
Justices of the next aforesaid nisi prius Oyer and terminer and Goal delivery for the County of
Dividing Creek the first Tuesday of September next and do not answer unto his Lordship the Lord
Proprietary of and concerning his being suspected of stealing a negro Boy belonging to a certain John Bitts
and do not stand and abide the Judgment of the Court thereon and do depart the same Court without leave
thereof and in the mean time if he is not of the good behaviour towards his said Lordship and all others
his good people &c

Likewise the aforesaid Thomas Lambden with James
Breeman and Robert Melvill all of Somerset County planters present herein Court in their proper persons
under oath for the said Sarah Lambden and each and every of them undertook and acknowledged themselves
indebted to his Lordship the Right Hon. the Lord Proprietary in manner and form
following viz the aforesaid Thomas Lambden in forty pounds Sterling and the aforesaid
James Breeman and Robert Melvill in twenty pounds Sterling each good and
Lawfull money of England of their severall goods and Chattels Lands & Tenements
of every of them to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors to be
made and levied.

If it happen that the aforesaid Sarah Lambden wife
of the aforesaid Thomas Lambden do not make her personall appearance before the
Justices of the next aforesaid nisi prius Oyer and terminer and Goal delivery to be held
for the County aforesaid at Dividing Creek the first Tuesday of September next and do not
answer unto his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary of and concerning her being
suspected of feloniously stealing a negro Boy belonging to a certain John Bitts and
do not stand and abide the Judgment of the Court thereon and do depart the same
Court without leave and in the mean time if she is not of the good behaviour
towards his said Lordship and all others his good people &c
