If it happen that the aforesaid John Britt do not make his personall appearance before the Justices of the next assize nisi prius Oyer and terminer and Goal delivery to be held for the County aforesaid at Dividing Creek the first Tuesday of September next and do not answer unto his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary of and concerning his being suspected of feloniously Stealing of a Negroe Boy belonging to a certain John Britt and do not stand and abide the judgement of the Court thereon and do not depart the same Court without leave and in the mean time if he is not of the good behaviour towards his said Lordship and all others his good People &c.

Whereupon the said John Britt, and a certain John Britt Junr and John Gouty all of Somerset County planters ^{are ordered to} give Security for their appearance before the Justices of the next assize nisi prius Oyer and terminer and Goal delivery to be held for Somerset County at Dividing Creek the first Tuesday of September next to give Evidence on behalfe of his said Lordship of Thomas Lambden Sarah Lambden and John Britt &c.

Thereupon the said John Britt with Edward Beachamp and William Adams his Security of Somerset County planters all present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves Debted unto his Lordship the right Honourable the Lord Proprietary in manner and form following viz. The aforesaid John Britt in forty pounds Sterling and the aforesaid Edward Beachamp and Wm. Adams in twenty pounds Sterling each good and Lawfull money of England of their severall goods & Chattels Lands and tenements of every of them to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors to be made and Levied.
