shire deceased being above the age of fourteen years came hencforth in his proper person and prays that he may be admitted to chose a certain David Wilson of said County Gent: as his guardian which is to him granted the said Andrew Thompson the younger makes choice of the said David Wilson as his guardian accordingly - whereupon the said David Wilson is ordered by the court here to take into his care and custody all the Estate of the said Andrew Thompson the younger both real and personal and likewise it is further ordered that the said David Wilson give security for to comply with the guardianship aforesaid

Whereupon the said David Wilson with Samuel Wilson his Servant of Somerset County Gent both present herein first in their proper persons acknowledged themselves indebted unto the said Andrew Thompson the younger in the sum of Two hundred pounds Sterling good and Lawfull money of England of their goods and Chattels Land and Tenements Securall to the use of the said Andrew Thompson his heirs and assigns to be made good - if it happeneth that the said David Wilson do not comply with the Law in Relation to such guardianship as aforesaid do not deliver up unto the said Andrew Thompson all his Estate both real and personal that he shall take into his hands and possession) peaceably and quietly when ever the same shall be legally required.
