Therefore it is considered that the aforesaid Sarah Staples of the premises as in the Indictment aforesaid mentioned be quitted and goe thereof without day etc.

Whereupon the said Sarah Staples is ordered to give security for to save and keep Indemnified the Justices of Somerset County Court and their Successors for the sume being from all Costs Charges Troubles and Burthenes that might accrue by means of the Birth of the Child aforesaid.

Whereupon the said Sarah Staples with Francis Porter and Williton Townend all of Somerset County planteys present here in Court acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his said Lordship the Proprietary in the sume of Twenty pounds Sterling good and Lawfull money of England of her Body Goods and Chattells Lands and tenements sojustly and severally to be made and Lained if either to the Justices of Somerset County If it happen that the said Sarah Staples her heirs Executors and Administrators or any of them do and shall not from time to time and at all times forever hereafter acquit her of all her aye and save herself as well the Justices of Somerset County Court for the sume being and their Successors as also the Inhabitants of the same County from all Costs Charges and Troubles whatsoever for or by reason of the Birth maintenance necessarie and bringing up of the said Child and of and from all other such Costs Charges Burthenes Troubles and demands whatsoever touching or concerning of the same etc Likewise the said Sarah Staples with the aforesaid Francis Porter and Williton Townend for Security all present here in Court in their pray or persons acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his Lordship in the sume of One Thousand and One hundred pounds to be Lained etc In case the said Sarah Staples do not pay unto the severall Creditors their fees due by occasion of the premises as upon the Indictment aforesaid.

The same Somerset County s^t The Jurers for the Right honourable the Lord Proprietary that now is for the body of Somerset County as upon their Oath do present that Rebecca Obry an late of all Hallows parish in the County of Somerset the tenth day of June in the year of our Lord God seventeen hundred thirty and six with force and arms at the Parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court one white Linnen Shift of the Value of fifty pounds of tobacco of the goods and chattells of the said Thomas Fletcher then and there being found there and there feloniously did steal take and bear away contrary to the peace of the said Lord Proprietary that now is his good rule and government aid against the form of the act of assembly in such case lately made and provided etc
