It was Endorsed as followeth vizt - Ignoramus of William Jones foreman -  
and afterwards in the same Court to wit the sixteenth day of November Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty Six the said Rebecca Bryan in her proper person appearing to a certain Recognizance by her and her security before ahus vldged and prays that her appearance may be returned and she and her security discharged from the same Recognizance.

Therupon the said Rebecca Bryans appearance is returned and she and her security is accordingly discharged &c. - Whereupon the said Rebecca Bryan is ordered to give security for the payment of the severall Officers fees due by means of the premises of Wherupon a certain Joshua Caldwell of Somerset County planter present here in Court in his proper person acknowledged himself indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in one thousand pounds of tobe. to be levied on his body goods and Chattells Lands and Tenements to the use of the severall Officers that hath a right to any fees in the premises of the said. If it happen that the said Rebecca Bryan do not pay the same fees as aforesaid -

Thomas Fletcher appears according to his Recognizance Entered into Last Court to give Evidence against Rebecca Bryan and is accordingly discharged &c.

John Redding appears according to his Recognizance Entered into for his good behaviour and appearance at this Court and he and his security is accordingly discharged Therupon the said John Redding is ordered to give security for the payment of the severall Officers their fees due by means of the premises of Wherupon Joshua Caldwell of Somerset County planter present here in Court undertook for the said John Redding for to pay the severall Officers fees due as aforesaid.

His Lordship - Somerset County ss<sup>ts</sup> The Jurors for the right honourable the Lord Proprietary that is for the body of Somerset County afo upon their Oath do present that Nehemiah Holland late of all hallows parish in the County afo planter the tenth day of August Anno Domini seventeen hundred thirty and six at the parish afo in the County afo within the Jurisdiction of this Court in and upon a certain Thomas Dargis of the same County planter in the peace of God and of the said Lord Proprietary then and there being with force and arms assaulted and the same Thomas then and there did beat wound and evilly treat so that of his life it was much despaired and other harms to him then and there did to the great damage of the same Thomas and against the peace of the said Lord Proprietary that now is his good rule and Government &c.
