unto all such matters and things as shall or may be objected against him in his Lordships behalf
and that he stands and abides the Judgment of the said Court as also that he do not depart the Country
without leave thereof and to be of good behaviour towards his Lordships and all his good people especially
towards his wife Elizabeth Nock who hath required surety of the peace of him that
then this Recognizance be void and of no effect or otherwise to stand and remaine in full force —
