 Beayly securities and did acknowledge themselves to owe and stand Justly Indebted unto the right
 Honourable the Lord Proprietary of Maryland in the sum of ten pounds sterling each to be levied
 of their Goods and Chattels Lands or Tenements in Case failure be made of the under written
 Condition — The Condition of this Recognizance is such that if the above bound John Noach
 shall make his personal appearance before his Lordships Justices of the peace for the County aforesaid
 at a Court to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of August next then and there to answer
 unto all such matters and things as shall or may be objected against him in his Lordships behalf
 and that he stand and abide the Judgment of the said Court as also that he do not depart the Court
 without leave thereof and to be of good behaviour towards his Lordships and all his good people
 especially towards his wife Elizabeth Noach who hath required surety of the peace of him what
 then this Recognizance be void and of no effect or otherwise to stand and remain in full force.

 thirty Six the Recognizance aforesaid and every thing therein relating is recorded by the
 Court here in the next Court to wit the sixteenth day
 of November Anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred and thirty Six before the Justices
 of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at Dividing Creek came the said John Knock
 in his proper person and prays that his appearance may be recorded & save himself &
 security from aforesaid Recognizance by him and his security before acknowledged
 Whereupon the said John Knocks appearance is recorded and he and his security discharged
