The next to give Evidence against John Mitchell Esq Wherupon the said Thomas Caldwell and Mathew Barramore both present hereon Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the sum of ten pounds Sterling each of their severall goods and Chattells Lands and tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors to be made and levied If it happen that the said Thomas Caldwell and Mathew Barramore do not make their personall appearance before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek in the same County the third Tuesday of March next and do not then and there give such Evidence as he knoweth against a certain John Mitchell Esq concerning his being suspected of feloniously stealing one hogg the goods and Chattells of a certain Mathew Barramore and do depart the same Court without leave &c

His Lordship William Jones of Somerset County planter gentleman Court in his proper person according to a certain Recouerance by him before acknowledged for William Jones his appearance here to give Evidence on Behalf of his Lordship against a certain John Mitchell, and prays that his appearance may be leinded and he discharged therefrom, Whereupon the said William Jones appearance is leinded and he accordingly discharged. Thereupon the said William Jones is ordered to give a new Recouerance in five pounds Sterling for his appearance before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek in the same County the third Tuesday of November next to give Evidence on behalf of his Lordship against the said John Mitchell Esq on suspicion of felony &c Whereupon the said William Jones present hereon Court in his proper person acknowledged himself Indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the sum of five pounds Sterling of his goods and Chattells Lands and tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors to be made and levied If it happen that the said William Jones do not make his personall appearance before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek in the same County the third Tuesday of November next and do not then and there give such Evidence as he knoweth against a certain John Mitchell Esq concerning his being suspected of feloniously stealing one hogg the goods and Chattells of a certain Mathew Barramore and do depart the same Court without leave &c
