sum of thirty pounds current money of Maryland due to be levied on their goods and Chattels
Lands and tenements for the use of his said Lordship if fail in the Condition here after mentioned
The Condition of the above Recognizance is such that if the above named George
M^r Lester doe make his Personall appearance before the Justices of our said County Court
to be held at dividing Creek the 2^d Tuesday of November Next to answer unto all such matters
and things as shall be Objected against him Concerning the Compounding a felony with a certain
Isaac Barker on behalf of his said Lordship and to stand and abide the Judgment of the said Court
and in the mean time to be of the good behaviour and not depart the Court without leave then
the above Recognizance to be void otherwise to stand in force and vertue in the Law

afterwards to wit the third Tuesday of November to wit the sixteenth day of the same
month and year One thousand seven hundred and thirty six came the same George
M^r Lester in his proper person according to a certain Recognizance by him and his Security
before acknowledged and prays that his appearance may be recorded to save him
self and Security from the recognizance of Mr. Thronpson the said George M^r Lester
appearance is recorded and he and his Security accordingly discharged &c.
