Thereupon the said Jane Culver is ordered to give security for the payment of the severall Officers fees due by evasion of the premises. Whereupon came her into Court a certain John Culver of Somerset County planter in his proper person and acknowledged himself Indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in five hundred pounds of tobacco of his body goods and Chattells Lands and Tenements to the use of the Officers of Somerset County Court that hath alight to any fees by means of the premises. If it happens that the said John Culver do not pay unto the severall Officers of Somerset County Court their Just fees due as aforesaid.

The name Heare. } that Thomas Heare late of Steaney parish in the County aforesaid planter the first day of November and one thousand seven hundred and thirty six at the parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court in and upon a certain Robert Mills of the same County planter in the peace of God and of the said Lord Proprietary then and there being with force and arms an assault did make and the same Robert then and did beat wound and cruelly treat so that of his life much impaired and other harm to him then and there did to the great damage of the same Robert and the peace of the said Lord Proprietary that now is his good rule and Government.
