

His Lordship } Memorandum that this day viz. the 13. Day of Decr. 1736

Joseph Powell } Came before me the Subscriber, one of his Lordships Justices of the peace for the County of Somerset Joseph Powell and his Security James Jones all of the County

and, did acknowledge themselves to be indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary Joseph Powell in the sum of ten pounds Sterling with his Security James Jones in the sum of five pound like money, all due to be levied on their body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements for the use of his Lordship the Lord Proprietary his heirs and Successors.

The Condition of the Recognizance is such that If the above bound Joseph Powell do make his person all appearance at Dividing Creek the 3. Tuesday of November next at a Court then and there to be held to answeres all such matters and things as shall be then and there Objected against him concerning a suspicion of killing a horse of George Oliver and to be of good behaviour, especially towards George Oliver and not depart the said Court without leave then this Recognizance to be void and of no effect or else to be in full force power and vertue taken by — M. B. Hill

Afterwards to wit the Sixteenth day of November and. D. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty Six before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset now hold at Dividing Creek in the same County came the said Joseph Powell in his proper person according to aforesaid recognizance by him and his security before acknowledged and prays that his appearance may be lauded and he and his security may be discharged & accordingly upon the said Joseph Powell's appearance is lauded and he and his security accordingly discharged &

Whereupon the said Joseph Powell is ordered to give security for the payment of the Several Taxes due by Omission of the premises and The Jurors of Somerset County shewer present before me and acknowledged himself indebted in the sum of £100 to his Lordship the Lord Proprietary to be levied on his body goods Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of the said Lord Proprietary and to the use of the said Lord Proprietary's Officers that have a right to any fees on the recognizance, and if it happen that the said Joseph Powell do not pay the same &

The Same } Somerset County shewer present before me and acknowledged himself indebted in the sum of £100 to his Lordship the Lord Proprietary and to the use of the said Lord Proprietary's Officers that have a right to any fees on the recognizance, and if it happen that the said Joseph Powell do not pay the same & The Jurors for the Right honorable the Lord Proprietary that now is for the body of Somerset County and upon their Oath do present that Michael Buge late of Stepney parish in the County of Spinkter the twenty second day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred thirty and six with force and Arm at the Parish and in the County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court one Gunblet mantle of the value of two hundred and one of tobacco of the goods and Chattels of Joanna Plugg then and there being found his and feloniously did steal take and bear away contrary to the peace of the said Lord Proprietary and that now is his good rule and Government and against the form of the Act of a Assembly in such case lately made and provided &
