being a bondman with John Givans who is deceased for the performance of the
administration and distribution of John Tillmans Estate now the widow of the said John
Intermarried with a certain Furnice Odear which Furnice Odear is lately deceased and the
Estate of the Orphans of the said John Tillman is squandering away your petitioner therefore
humbly prays your worships to order that a Summons may Issue requiring the Widow
Rose Tillman Alias Odear to give sufficient Security to keep harmless your petitioner and
the Exors of John Givans from the bond they entered into with the said Rose Tillman Alias
Odear or other ways deliver the Estate belonging to the Orphans of John Tillman to your
petitioners, they returning an Account to your worships of what that they receive Agreeable
to the Act of Assembly in such case provided and your petitioner as in duty bound shall
ever pray

The petition being read and heard and fully understood and the said
Rose Tillman Alias Odear being here present in Court, as well as the petitioner Aaron Tillman
and the Court having heard the severall allegations as well on the part of the petitioner as
on the part of the said Rose Tillman Alias Odear, and for as much as it doth appear to the
Court here that the said Rose Tillman Alias Odear is not able to give the petitioner Security
as the Law in such Cases directs but the said Rose Tillman Alias Odear is willing to surrender
and deliver up unto the said Aaron Tillman all the Estate of the said John Tillman that she
hath in her hands and which of right doth belong unto the Children of the said John Tillman

Upon which Court do appoint Richard Chambers and James Furnace of Somerset
County Justs to Reappraise the Estate of the said John Tillman in the hands of the said Rose
Tillman Alias Odear unto the said Aaron Tillman - And if it should happen hereafter upon
the said Aaron Tillmans making application unto the said Rose Tillman Alias Odear for the said
Estate and the said Rose should refuse to deliver the same, that then the said Aaron Tillman
might again to a Justice and make affidavit of the said Rose Refusall, and that the
said Justice upon the Request of the said Aaron to Issue his Warrant to the Clerk of the
County Court of Somerset whereby directing him to Issue attachment against the said Rose
in order to possess the said Aaron with the Estate of the said John Tillman
