whereas aforesaid Henry the nineteenth day of January in the Year of our Lord God seventeen hundred thirty and five at Somerset County aforesaid by his certain bill obligatory which the same Thomas with the seal of the aforesaid Henry sealed hereinto Court both bring the date whereof is the same day and year had acknowledged himself to owe unto the aforesaid Thomas the aforesaid sum of twelve hundred and eight pounds of good tobacco to be paid unto the aforesaid Thomas when therefore afterwards he should be required to which payment well and truly to be made the aforesaid Henry did bind himself firmly by the same bill Nevertheless the aforesaid Henry altho often required the aforesaid sum of tobacco unto the same Thomas yet hath not paid but that unto him hitherto to pay altogether hath refused and still doth refuse to the damage of the same Thomas two thousand four hundred pounds of tobacco and thereupon he bringeth suit &c

And the aforesaid Henry Wriggle by William Beddingham his attorney saith that he doth not gain say the action of the aforesaid Thomas nor can he say but that the writing obligatory aforesaid is the deed of the same Henry nor but that he owes the same Thomas the aforesaid sum of Twelve hundred and Eight pounds of tobacco in manner and form as the aforesaid Thomas first above against him hath declared wherefor the same Thomas craves Judgment for his debt aforesaid and his damages sustained by reason of the detaining of the same debt to him to be adjudged &c

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the said Thomas Walker's answer against the aforesaid Henry Wriggle his debt aforesaid and his damages sustained by reason of the detaining of the same debt to One hundred & Eighty Seven pounds of tobacco to the said Thomas of his aforesaid by the Court here adjudged and the aforesaid Henry Wriggle
