Therefore it is considered that he and his pledges of promising to wit John Doe and Richard Roe be in mercy and that the said Capell King by virtue of the same Benjamin goe thereof without day &c also it is considered that the said Capell King recover against the said Whittington King his Damages aforesaid by reason of the premises aforesaid to the sum of Three hundred and Twenty Seven pounds of lawful money of the said Capell at his request for his costs and charges in that part sustained according to the form of the Statute therein made and provided by the Court has adjudged and the said Capell have the same of execution &c
