The same Charles in Consideration thereof that Bill aforesaid right the ^{use} of Merchants for all the time aff-
orded and approved the same day and year last mentioned at Somerset County 1736 by the aforesaid Robert Mack-
farling delivered as aforesaid to the said Charles he the said Charles did accept and with his proper hand subscribed
for seventeen thousand five hundred Shingles part of the said nineteen thousand shingles contained in
the aforesaid Bill to him as aforesaid directed (as by the same Bill and acceptance the aforesaid merchant
appears) and also then and there ^{and} on the day and year at the place last mentioned upon himself did
affirm and to the same Robert then and there faithfully did promise that he the said Charles aforesaid
seventeen thousand five hundred shingles (parcell of the said nineteen thousand shingles in the
said Bill contained to the said Robert Mackfarling when he should be thereunto requested he
would well and faithfully pay and content of which said seventeen thousand five hundred shing-
gles the said Robert Mackfarling acknowledges himself to be satisfied four thousand six hundred
shingles parcell thereof) Nevertheless the aforesaid Charles as to thirteen thousand five hundred
shingles residue little regarding but evily and fraudulently intending the said Robert Mackfar-
ling in that part craftily and subtilly to deceive and defraud the aforesaid thirteen thousand five
shingles residue of the aforesaid seventeen thousand five hundred shingles or any part thereof unto
the said Robert Mackfarling hath not paid or for the same in any sort contented altho to
do the same by the aforesaid Robert Mackfarling afterward (so will on the aforesaid fifteenth day
of November Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty four at Somerset County within
the Jurisdiction of the aforesaid Charles was requested but the same to him hitherto to pay or for in any sort
to intent the said Charles hath refused and still doth refuse Wherefore the said Robert Mackfar-
ling with that he is the wronger hath damage to the value of twenty pounds current money of
Maryland and thereof he brings suit

And therupon came hereinto Court Thomas Lamden and John Ramsey both of Somerset County
planters in their proper persons and undertook and each of them undertook and affirmed upon their
Affidavit the said Charles Ramsey present before me in his proper person affirmed upon his
Affidavit if in case the said Robert Mackfarling should recover judgment in the aforesaid a/c
that he the said Charles Ramsey or his two said Children Ramsey should be bound Convinced that then he
the said Charles Ramsey shall pay the Judgment of the Court to you or under his Body in
consideration of such Judgment to be given on the aforesaid of the Sheriff of Somerset County in satisfaction thereof
or that they the same Thomas Lamden and John Ramsey or either of them will do the same
for him &c And therupon the said Charles Ramsey prayeth that the said Robert Mackfarling
may give Security for costs in case nonsuit be obtained against him in the plea aforesaid which is by the Court
here granted. Whereupon after the said Robert Denzilis Henry of Somerset County Gentleman present before
me bound in his proper person and undertakes for the said Robert Mackfarling that in case he be nonsuited in
the plea aforesaid or otherwise Legally first that then the said Robert Mackfarling shall pay the Condemnation of
