All which said next Court to wit the seventeenth day of August anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and thirty six came againe as well the said Tabitha Barker as the said James McDonald and Margaret his wife by their attorneys aforesaid and whereupon the same James McDonald and Margaret his wife pray further Leave thereof to Judgment here until next Court & they have it and the same day is given to the said Tabitha here also &c
