Writter all of Somerset County Gent: Greeting know ye that we have appointed you or any three or two of you to be our Commissioners to examine evidences on behalf of a certain Thomas Benington of the County afo: in Relation to bounds of a tract of Land called Walthoe Neck, lying in the County afo: We therefore require you or any three or two of you at some time and place as to you or any three or two of you shall seem convenient you meet on the afo: Land called Walthoe Neck (you first having taken your oaths on the holy evangelist of almighty God according to act of assembly in such case made and provided) and there cause to come before you or any three or two of you all such evidences as shall be to you or any three or two of you nominated by the said Col: Benington or def: if any and that you or any three or two of you examine them upon their Corporall oaths to be by you or any three or two of you Administred on the holy Evangelist of almighty God in the presence of the Complainant or def: if any touching the truth or Falsity in consequence of their knowledge or any thing that may relate to the Cause afo: and that reducing the severall depositions into writing you set the same together with this our Commission under your or any three or two of your hands and seals to us to our County Court of Somerset with all convenient speed Witness Pro: King our Chief Justice of our said Court the nineteenth day of June in the 22^d Year of our Dominion: 1736 Done at one thousand seven hundred and thirty six

Now hence at this day to wit the sixteenth day of November and one thousand seven hundred and thirty six Came here unto Court James Memoria Day Scott and alex: Laskoy three of the Gent: mentioned in the above Commission and made Labura that of Evidence with severall depositions thereunto annexed in Somerset County. On the 20th day of Aug: 1736 Lane before me the Subscriber one of his Lordships Justices of the peace for the County of W: James Memoria one of the within Commission and was duly qualified for the Exam: the within Commission according to the act of assembly in that case made and provided Tho: Gullis

Some County J^{ts}: There are to certify all persons whom it may concern that the within mentioned Alexander Laskoy did appear by me one of his Lordships Justices of the peace for the County of W: and made oath on the holy evangelist of almighty God that he would truly and impartially execute his power and authority given to him in the within Commission according to act of assembly in such case made and provided this 20th of Aug: 1736 Will: Doughton

Memorandum that this day to wit the 6th day of 7^{br}: Lane before me one of his Lordships Justices of the peace for Somerset sh^{re}: Day Scott and made oath that he would well and truly execute the within Commission according to Law if that Law made and provided . . .
